- Counseling/ Case Management
- Therapy

Our Circle of Hope Program links individuals at Hope House with mental health and substance abuse services at ReDiscover, as well as with many important resources in the community.

We offer assistance and support to help transform lives hurt by domestic violence.

- Co-pays/ fees for psychiatric medication.
- Referrals and appointments for medical providers; transportation to treatment
- Applying for affordable housing and housing assistance programs
- Searching for jobs and completing employment applications, Assistance with resumes
- Public assistance, food stamps, and Medicaid
